



## Educational Program for Ukrainians

The tragedy of the war in Ukraine will leave scars for a generation. The Educational Equality Institute and our partners are standing firm TODAY in support of refugees and families fleeing the conflict in Ukraine.

**The program:** The Educational Equality Institute are organizing free language and educational courses for Ukrainians that have arrived in a new country. Both online and offline (depending on location) courses are offered.

With the help of our partner Your Personal Professor, we're able to offer a wide range of educational programs.

Our partner's qualified teachers will plan the curriculum and oversee the programs. The courses are held by Ukrainian teachers who have escaped the war themselves, volunteers, and teachers from our partner. This will provide the benefit of both providing a source of income to Ukrainian teachers and education to Ukrainian refugees across Europe.

- Language courses

Currently, language courses are available for:

- English
- French
- Lithuanian

More languages courses are being prepared and will be rolled out on an ongoing basis.

- Digital Competence & Integration
- Community spaces / mentoring / language practice
- Higher educational continuation programs.

### Language courses:

The language courses are designed to be fun and challenging, and a good way to learn the language while making new friends and learning about the new language and country. The courses focus to a large extent on oral language skills. Students will practice phrases and pronunciation, and they will be able to have conversations about their daily life. Students will also practice reading and writing simple texts and listening to the language spoken.

The courses are divided into courses for children and adults. Language classes are divided into beginner and intermediate courses. The course the student will attend is decided by their own evaluation of their current skill and which course they want to attend. Course sizes are set to have 10-15 students per class.

The classes will be held online through the Equanet LSM system and offline where this is possible.

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### **The Educational Equality Institute**

The Educational Equality Institute is a registered Non-Government Organisation (NGO NO Reg 928 778 274) headquartered in Oslo, Norway. The Educational Equality Institute through a combination of educational programs and advocacy supports people in disadvantaged situations to not only access quality education but to flourish therein.

### **Educational Programs:**

#### **Language Courses**

The courses are held by Ukrainian teachers and our volunteer teachers and will help participants to improve their language skills in the selected language and learn how to apply them in daily life.

#### **Digital Competence & Integration**

The courses will cover a range of areas – finding accommodation, employment, and gaining access to community services that they will need. Training will be available for digital literacy, CV writing, and how to market their skills online among others. More courses in different areas will be set up based on feedback and opportunity.

#### **Mentoring & Community**

Online spaces through the Equanet platform will be set up for educational support, mentoring to provide advice and support and language practice between sessions. Local volunteers will be able to sign up for the program and be matched with a Ukrainian refugee that aligns with their needs and location. All mentors/volunteers will be vetted by The Educational Equality support team before being accepted.

#### **Higher Educational continuation programs.**

Students who have seen their education cut short because of the war will be offered free tutoring sessions and mentorship to be able to continue and finish their degrees in a successful way.
