

C O M M U N I Q U E

For the benefit of the development of mutual sports contacts and friendly relations between LITHUANIA and SWEDEN, negotiations between official representatives of Lithuanian State Sports Department and the Swedish Sports Confederation were held in Vilnius, September 11th, 1990

The delegation were composed as follows:

For Lithuanian State Sports Department

Mr. Algirdas Raslanas, director general

For the Swedish Sports Confederation

Mr. Stig Hedlund, Director of International Relations

The two parties discussed sports development in Lithuania as well as in Sweden and agreed upon furthering the sports contacts.

The Parties discussed co-operation in further developing sports training methods, exchange of sports athletes and teams, participation in seminars and clinics on improvement of high performance sport, exchange of information on organization of mass sport, sports recreation and company sport. Also establishing contacts in marketing of sports. The doping problem was discussed in particular.

The Protocols in the coming years shall not exclude additional sports arrangements by agreement between the 2 - two parties and separate agreements between Federations and Sport organizations for students and youth.


As a start of the annual exchange, the Parties also agreed upon meeting in November, 1990 to sign the Protocol concerning Sports exchange for 1991.

The Parties agreed to settle financial conditions on signing sports exchange protocol for 1991.

This Communique shall commence on the day of its signing. It is valid for a period of 3 - three years, and after that period the Communique may be considered valid for the next three years period unless one of the Parties terminates the Communique by 6 - six months notice in writing.
